**MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION AND CATEGORIES**

1. Those interested may join the Club as Associate, Family or Junior (u/18) Members.
2. To become an Ordinary member a person must:  
have been an associate member for a minimum of 12 months  
**AND**  
be legally entitled to pilot a manned aircraft **OR** have a project **OR** aircraft
4. Family membership is available to the spouse or personal partner of an Ordinary member
5. The committee shall consider each proper application for membership at a committee meeting and shall accept or reject such applications
6. Club Year commences on July 1<sup>st</sup>. fees are payable on application- no part year fees available.
7. An associate member has all club privileges except:  
·Voting /Holding office / Basing an aircraft at Serpentine / Owning or occupying a hangar site

**HANGAR SITES**

Please note that due to developmental constraints there is a limited amount of space available for hangars at Serpentine. Only full members are eligible to apply for and be allocated a hangar site.

**AIRCRAFT AT SERPENTINE**

Full members(Ordinary or Life) may apply to committee to have aircraft approved to be based at Serpentine. All will be considered with regard to the club ratio rules.

Members with aircraft that are not on the approved list are welcome to visit the airfield for a period not exceeding one day.

Members wishing to keep aircraft temporarily at Serpentine for longer periods must obtain permission from committee. A fee may apply.
