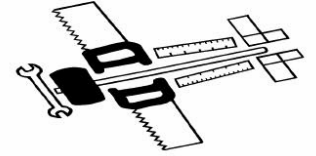

Membership Information and Categories

The following is a brief explanation of the current Membership categories. Also see below for extracts from our Constitution which is available from our website.

1. New applicants can join the Club as Associate, Family or Junior Members.
2. After a minimum of one year an Associate Member can apply for Ordinary Membership provided the qualifications as set out in the Constitution are met.
3. Existing Ordinary Members may apply for transfer to Associate Membership.
4. Family membership is only available to the spouse or personal partner of a Full Member.
5. Full fees are payable in the first year and no pro-rata discount is provided for joining part way through a financial year. Our financial year is from 1st. July to 30th. June.
6. Full Membership upgrade is only available after a minimum of 1 year as an Associate Member

Extracts from the Constitution

Any person interested in the objects of the Club shall be eligible to apply for Associate Membership. An Associate Member has all Club privileges except to vote, hold office, base an aircraft at Serpentine Airfield or own or occupy a hangar or site.

The Committee shall consider each proper application for membership at a Committee Meeting and shall accept or reject such applications.

Current Ordinary Members may elect to become Associate Members.

An Associate Member of no less than 12 months standing, who is legally entitled to pilot a manned aircraft or has a project or aircraft, may apply to become an Ordinary Member.
