Please be advised that the 27<sup>th</sup> West Australian Light Aircraft Championships (WALAC) will be taking place on the weekend of 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> November 2002, at Jandakot Airport.

This annual event is usually held towards the end of February, however, with the Centenary of Powered Flight in 2003 and its associated celebrations, including the Australian Light Aircraft Championships (ALAC) being brought forward, it was considered appropriate to hold WALAC earlier than normal in order to select a team for ALAC.

WALAC is open to every Western Australian pilot from Student to CPL, although some restrictions apply, and is traditionally administered by the Royal Aero Club of Western Australia (RACWA). WALAC endeavours to promote sport aviation throughout WA and covers many facets of "club flying" including: Formation, Aerobatics, Streamer Cutting, Glide Approach and Precision Circuits.

There is a post competition dinner held in the RACWA members lounge which includes announcing the days winners along with presentations to those successful candidates.
