Lunch will be available upon your arrival and time to chat with other participants. A bus will be available to travel the 10kms into town. Concession tickets to the festival can be purchased as you get off the bus if you would like the reduced price, then you are free to come and go as you please. Some suggestions include the wonderful 25m outdoor pool, the local pub, deli, or visitors information centre or go straight into the oval for the outdoor concert entertainment provided by bands from all over Australia. Food and drinks will be available on the oval including a licensed bar and wine tasting. Local arts and crafts will be on display or you can try your luck in side show alley. Harley Davidson rides are also available .

Most attractions are within walking distance of the town centre, buses are constantly in town to take visitors out to Harvey Dickson's Country Music Centre, which is well worth a look. Transport will be available back to the strip in the evening if you will be leaving. Tents are allowed along the airstrip and water and toilets will be provided if you would like to stay with your plane, bus times are on the reverse of this flyer. Accommodation is available in town but you will need to book early as it is already disappearing. Sunday morning there will be an early bus run for those that stayed in town before breakfast is cooked at the airstrip.
