I was informed by members of the SABC, that the Langley Park Fly In on April 27 is not going ahead this year.

They did ask me if we could organise a Fly In this year, because 2003 marks the centenary of aviation.

I can now confirm that we have approval for a Centenary of Aviation Fly In on Sunday 27 April 2003. We will celebrate 100 years of powered flight. Each aircraft will represent 10 years.

We are holding an information briefing on Thursday 3 April 17.15 hr at the Royal Aero Club. Anybody who is interested to participate is invited to come along to that meeting. We are looking for: 10 special aircraft to land at Langley, aircraft to participate in a low level fly by, vintage cars / motorbikes to be paraded next to the aircraft and we are looking for people who can help on the ground.

The Royal Aero Club is the main sponsor of this event. But it is an open event and hopefully everybody will join the celebration.

The aim of the day is to make people in WA aware of the centenary of powered flight, promote general aviation and lobby for Langley Park as one of the most unique airfields in the world.
