

AVIATION CHALLENGE 2002

We invite you to enter a team in the **Aviation Challenge** to be held in the **Royal Australian Air Force Association, Bullcreek Drive, Bullcreek at 7.45 p.m. on Thursday, August 1st, 2002**. Please note the change of venue due to renovations at the WACA.

The format is similar to that which you would experience at a general quiz night for your local hockey club or school - excepting that **all** the questions have some link with aviation. However, they are sufficiently diverse to avoid favouring any group with a particular interest.

The major prize is a sum of \$400, together with the Masterminds Trophy and commemorative Gold Medallions. In addition there are some sectional prizes for all other categories of teams. A variety of additional competitions are conducted throughout the evening.

If you hold one of the perpetual trophies from the 2001 competition, we urge that you **return it to us by Friday, July 5th, 2002** (which incidentally is the last Friday of Semester 1). This should provide sufficient time for the engravers to prepare them for distribution on the night.

The Aviation Quiz is the only social function in the aviation calendar which brings together people from **all** aspects of aviation. Teams from the city, the country and even interstate come to 'pit their wits' against the best in the aviation fraternity.

The **RAAF Association** is a licensed venue and the tables will be arranged in a similar format at that of previous years.

There is no "door charge" for entry to this event. **Tables** are purchased in advance and allocated in order of receipt of the application form. Because of this method of sales, a table costs the same whether it is occupied by the **minimum** number of contestants (one), or the **maximum** (six). Teams may enter as representatives of an organisation (Corporate or Youth), or as Private teams. The Corporate teams pay more - but they are usually sponsored and always have access to a greater number of prizes.

We look forward to you becoming part of this huge social occasion which regularly attracts between fifty and sixty teams. **Tables are allocated from the front on a first-come first-served basis** upon receipt of your application. As you may know, there are certain advantages to being near the front.

RULES

1. A team shall consist of not more than 6 participants (see also rule 11).
2. Six sets of 10 question will be asked.
3. Questions will be as diverse as possible but all will relate to AVIATION.
4. Teams may win more than one prize according to category and sub-category entries.
5. Teams shall be entered in the Quiz as either **CORPORATE, PRIVATE OR YOUTH** teams. Entries in these sections are mutually exclusive excepting that for the payment of the **CORPORATE** fee, a YOUTH team may also enter in the Corporate Category.
6. Members of teams in the **YOUTH CATEGORY** must be less than 18 years of age on 30th July, 2002 and be currently undertaking secondary schooling. In addition, all participants must be current members of the organization which they represent. Teams comprising past members of a youth organization may represent that organization in the CORPORATE competition - but not in the YOUTH competition.
7. Additional competitions will be run concurrently with the AVIATION QUIZ. One such competition will be to determine the **INDIVIDUAL AVIATION MASTERMIND** among the assembled contestants. Results gained in an additional competition will be used to decide places if a tie occurs in one of the sub-category competitions. (See also rule 10)
8. The event is principally organised by the **AERONAUTICS DEPARTMENT** from KENT STREET SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL. Proceeds from the evening will be used to foster aviation education and youth flying.
9. In the event of dispute arising over answers, they will be considered by the designated adjudicator. His/her decision will be final and binding on all parties.
10. A tie for the **Masterminds of Aviation** will result in a "Sudden Death" series of questions to decide the winners. Ties occurring in **any of the Sectional competitions** will be decided by the relative placement of the tied teams in the designated additional competition.
11. Teams may be accompanied by non-participants (spouses etc.) subject to accommodation and the payment of \$5 per person. These people can take part in the variety of additional competitions during the evening but must remain strictly as spectators during the Quiz. Should accommodation not be available, teams will be advised and a refund made after the closing date for entries. **Adult non-participants are not allowed in youth teams.**
12. **Contestants are not permitted to bring flight computers, ERSA, reference books, calculators, manuals or any other materials designed to give them an unfair advantage over other contestants. The use of mobile phones to obtain answers is not permitted.**

13. THE CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES is Tuesday, 30th July, 2002. Entries will be acknowledged by email or post where possible – otherwise by phone.
